Music Theory Electives - 1.0 full course equivalents in graduate-only music theory courses (to be taken in Year 1)

Electives – 1.0 full course equivalents (to be taken in Year 1). 0.5 may be taken outside musicology, ethnomusicology and music theory (in any graduate unit). With approval, one 0.5 full course equivalents may be deferred to the first session of Year 2.

Course Weight (i.e. 0.5 or 1.0) *

Language Requirements – Primary and secondary languages (to be met by the end of Year 2)

Comprehensive Exams – set of 3 exams in contemporary issues, history of the field and repertoire (to be completed in fall term of Year 2)

Major Field Exam – to be completed in winter term of Year 2

Candidacy achieved or Extension to Achieve Candidacy request submitted – by end of Year 3

Research & Thesis Writing – Years 3 & 4

Thesis Defense – Year 4

*courses with an "H" designation have a course weight of 0.5 full course equivalents. Courses with a "Y" designation have a weight of 1.0.

Student in the **PhD in Music Theory** program must complete a total of 3.0 full-course equivalents, language requirements, comprehensive exams, a major field exam and a thesis.
